SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 314, L.D. 1082, Bill, "An Act to Amend the State's Overtime Law"

Amend the amendment in subsection 5 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 35 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "has" and inserting in its place the following: 'and that person's supervisor have'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "hours." and inserting in its place the following: 'hours; and'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 5 by inserting after paragraph B the following:

'C. Other staff of equivalent qualifications is available to ensure adequate patient staffing and quality care.'


SUMMARY
