2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §603, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 1999, c. 750,
§1, is amended to read:

6 **2. Limits on mandatory overtime.** An employer may not
8 require an employee to work more than ~~80~~ 60 hours of overtime in
any consecutive 2-week period.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill limits the amount of mandatory overtime to 60
14 hours of overtime in any consecutive 2-week period.
