	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2414, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

	7. Fleeing a motor vehicle. A person commits a Class E
6	crime if that person, after being signaled to stop a motor
	vehicle on request or signal of a uniformed law enforcement
8	officer, attempts to flee from the motor vehicle with the intent
	of eluding arrest. This subsection only applies to the driver of
10	the motor vehicle.

	This bill creates the crime of fleeing a motor vehicle to
16	prohibit a driver of a motor vehicle signaled to stop by a law enforcement officer from attempting to elude arrest by leaving
18	the motor vehicle.
