COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 320, L.D. 1088, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Literacy of Adults in the State"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds in the form of a grant to Literacy Volunteers of America in Maine in order to provide equity of access to basic literacy services statewide by establishing programs in underserved areas and by increasing the capacity of existing programs through the expansion of technical assistance to local volunteer literacy organizations.'
