
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 322, L.D. 1090, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Requirement that School Employees be Fingerprinted"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 15 (page 11, lines 22 to 29 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision that requires the Commissioner of Education to reinstate the certification, authorization, approval or renewal under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 501 or 502 that was denied to a person solely on the basis of that person's refusal to comply with the requirements of Title 20-A, former section 6103.
