Sec. 1. Medicaid reimbursement for persons with brain injuries.

2 **Resolved:** That by January 1, 2002, the Department of Human
3 Services shall adopt rules to amend its state plan to provide
4 Medicaid reimbursement for supervised housing to a person with a
5 brain injury. For the purposes of this section, "brain injury"
6 means an injury caused by external means other than hereditary,
7 congenital or degenerative factors to the brain of a person that
8 results in an impairment of cognitive abilities or physical
9 functioning or a disturbance in the behavioral or emotional
10 functions of the person with the brain injury. Rules adopted
11 pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined
12 in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter
13 II-A.
