2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §375, sub-§1-A** is enacted to read:

6 1-A. Location of lottery machines. The director may issue
8 a license to sell lottery tickets to an applicant who meets the
requirements of subsection 1 regardless of the location of any
existing lottery sales agent.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill allows the Director of Alcoholic Beverages and
14 Lottery Operations to issue licenses as an agent to sell lottery
16 tickets to anyone who meets the requirements no matter how close
the new location would be to any other location.
