SUMMARY

4 This amendment replaces the bill and is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice. The amendment gives the court authority to prohibit a person who is the subject of a temporary protection from abuse order from 8 possessing a firearm or other dangerous weapon for the duration of the order, if the court determines that the defendant has a 10 history of violence.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
