2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §111, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 1987, c. 188,
§1, is further amended to read:

6 **3. Residence.** He The person must have established and
8 maintain a voting residence in that municipality for at least 30
days before an election.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides that a person must establish and maintain
14 residency in a municipality for at least 30 days before an
election in order for that person to register to vote in that
16 municipality.
