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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 336, L.D. 1143, Bill, "An Act to Allow Principals of Limited Liability Corporations to Appear in Court in Forcible Entry and Detainer Cases"

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Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

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'An Act to Allow Members, Managers and Authorized Employees to Appear in Court for a Limited Liability Company'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in subparagraph (1) in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or" and inserting in its place the following: 'or'

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C in subparagraph (2) in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or"

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Further amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C by striking out all of subparagraph (3).

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FISCAL NOTE

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The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with

2 the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the
court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease
4 General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

8 This amendment deletes the proposed addition of forcible
entry and detainer actions to the list of court actions in which
10 a person who is not an attorney may appear on behalf of the
person's organization.
