Economic development districts are to request funds from their 34 allotment on a project-by-project basis, based on the comprehensive economic strategy. Forty percent of the funds will be used to support statewide 44 attraction efforts, including a direct foreign investment program; 40% will be used to support regional and local 46 business attraction efforts; and 20% will be used to enhance regional and statewide efforts through focused advertising and 48 other targeted marketing.

SUMMARY

6 This amendment strikes and replaces the original bill. It includes annual General Fund appropriations totaling \$4,571,000 for the Department of Economic and Community Development. 8 It provides \$1,200,000 in regional development block grants and 10 \$200,000 to secure federal planning grants to assist communities suffering from the loss of major employers. The amendment also 12 provides \$500,000 for business attraction and expansion marketing efforts and \$1,000,000 to recapitalize the Maine Microenterprise 14 Initiative. The amendment also provides \$200,000 over the biennium to recapitalize the fund that provides grants to avoid 16 or alleviate the impact caused when a community loses a mature or dominant industry. It also provides one-time funds for the construction of the River Valley Technical Center incubator 18 facility and matching funds for the Schoodic education and research center. The amendment also appropriates \$35,000 in 20 one-time funds to assist the Maine Film Office to upgrade digital 22 technology and \$100,000 for the Maine Products Marketing Program. This amendment adds an emergency preamble and clause 24 and fiscal note to the bill.

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
