Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill includes General Fund appropriations totalling \$30,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$40,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Department of Corrections to lease one vehicle for each regional probation office to assist in transporting persons involved with probation violations.
