COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 350, L.D. 1164, Bill, "An Act to Facilitate the Creation of Boat Launch Sites in the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission's Jurisdiction"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A by striking out all of paragraph C (page 1, lines 39 to 50 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'C. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands are not required to obtain a permit for construction of a public boat launch on a lake classified as a Management Class 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7 lake as defined in rule adopted by the commission as long as the notification requirements and project standards for a public boat launch established in rule are met.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report. This amendment clarifies that a permit is not required for a public boat launch on a Management Class 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7 lake when notification and other standards established in rule are met.
