HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 879, L.D. 1171, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission to Introduce Legislation and to Organize Assemblies of State and Tribal Leaders"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Authorize the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission to Organize Assemblies of State and Tribal Leaders'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 1, lines 14 to 18 in L.D.)


FISCAL NOTE
