	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶L, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	342, §1 and affected by §9, is amended to read:
б	L. Smoking is not prohibited in a retail store under 2,000 2,500 square feet that primarily sells tobacco or
8	tobacco-related products, even if food or alcohol is sold or served on the premises, as long as at least 3/5 of the
10	revenue of the store is derived from sales of tobacco and tobacco-related products.

14	SUMMARY
16	This bill clarifies that smoking is not prohibited in a shop as long as at least 3/5 of the shop's revenue is derived from
18	sales of tobacco and tobacco-related products even if alcohol or food is sold or served on the premises. This bill also increases
20	the square footage limitation to 2,500 square feet.
