SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 883, L.D. 1175, Bill, "An Act to Require that Benefits for Total Disability be Continued During a Period of Vocational Rehabilitation under the Workers' Compensation Act"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Require that Benefits for Disability be Continued During a Period of Vocational Rehabilitation under the Workers' Compensation Act''

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4-A in the last line (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "212" and inserting in its place the following: '213'

SUMMARY

This amendment limits continuation of benefits during rehabilitation to an employee who is partially incapacitated.
