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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 883, L.D. 1175, Bill, "An Act to Require that Benefits for Total Disability be Continued During a Period of Vocational Rehabilitation under the Workers' Compensation Act"

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 39-A MRSA §217, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

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4-A. Continuation of benefits during rehabilitation. During the time that an employee is engaged in a full-time rehabilitation program ordered or approved by the board under this section, that employee is presumptively entitled to receive benefits for disability under section 212.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment rewrites the proposed law, places it in a more appropriate section of law and limits its application to employees in full-time rehabilitation programs.
