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SUMMARY

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This amendment amends the Maine Pediatric Dental Recruitment Incentive provisions of the bill. It allows an awardee to receive a grant based on establishing residency and a pediatric dental practice and committing in writing to practicing for at least one year and to serving children in the Medicaid and Cub Care programs. It replaces the appropriation section and adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
