4 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2916** is enacted to read:

6 **§2916. Flags for public servants**

8 The commissioner shall provide an American flag for the  
10 grave site of each public servant listed on the memorials located  
12 at the State Capitol complex memorial site.

16 This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Public Safety to provide a flag for the grave sites of certain public servants who are listed on the memorials located at the State Capitol complex memorial site.
