COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 364, L.D. 1202, Bill, "An Act to Allow Families to Request Flags for Deceased Police Officers and Firefighters that have not Died in the Line of Duty"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~\$2916.~~" in the next to the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "receive a" the following: '3 x 5 feet'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Public Safety could incur significant additional General Fund costs to comply with the requirement that a state flag can be requested from the department by the families of deceased firefighters or law enforcement officers. The final costs will depend on how many flags are requested; the amounts can not be determined at this time.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the size of the flag the Commissioner of Public Safety is required to present to the family of a deceased firefighter or law enforcement officer upon request by the family of the deceased.
