	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2916 is enacted to read:

6	§2916. Flags for deceased firefighters and law enforcement officers
8	In recognition of the indispensable public service that firefighters and law enforcement officers play in the well-being
10	of the citizens of this State, the family of a deceased firefighter or law enforcement officer, upon request to the
12	Department of Public Safety, is entitled to receive a state flag from the office of the commissioner.

18	This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Public Safety to present a state flag to the family of a deceased firefighter or
