COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 376, L.D. 1214, Bill, "An Act to Encourage the Use of Locally Grown Foods in School Food Service Programs"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

General Purpose Aid for Local Schools

All Other \$37,200

Provides funding for reimbursement of one dollar to local school administrative units for every \$3 of food products purchased that were grown in the State of Maine up to a maximum reimbursement of \$1,000.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
