COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 904, L.D. 1218, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Calculation for Annual County Tax Assessments"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The requirement that county commissioners must apportion certain budgeted costs among the municipalities and unorganized territories within the county represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs can not be determined at this time. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and 2/3 of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, the counties may not be required to implement these changes.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
