Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 18-A MRSA §5-509, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 711, §1,
4 is repealed.

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Sec. 2. 33 MRSA c. 7, sub-c. III-A, as enacted by PL 1999, c.
711, §3, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the prohibition against an electronic or
digital signature on a durable power of attorney or deed,
14 mortgage or other document affecting title to real property in
order to bring Maine law into conformity with federal law.
