	The reinstatement of the sales tax exemption on leases of
28	certain motor vehicles to nonresidents effective July 1, 2003 will decrease sales and use tax collections by \$238,471 in fiscal
30	year 2003-04 and \$250,394 in fiscal year 2004-05. The reduction
	of these tax collections will decrease the amounts transferred to
32	the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing by
34	\$12,400 in fiscal year 2003-04 and \$13,020 in fiscal year
04	2004-05. The resulting net reductions of General Fund revenue will be \$226,071 in fiscal year 2003-04 and \$237,374 in fiscal

10	additional costs to administer these provisions. These costs can
