CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill to clarify application and proposes the "prevailing wage enforcement of laws concerning the and 10 benefits," which means the hourly wage and benefits paid to the median number of workers employed in a trade or occupation on the 12 2nd and 3rd week in September, to ensure that the economic welfare of workers in Maine is enhanced and not undermined. 14
