10 This bill proposes to clarify the application and  
enforcement of laws concerning the "prevailing wage and

median number of workers employed in a trade or occupation on the  
2nd and 3rd week in September, to ensure that the economic  
14 welfare of workers in Maine is enhanced and not undermined.
