Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 305,
4 §1, is amended to read:

1. Minimum wage. The minimum hourly wage is \$4.25 \$5.15 per hour. If-the-highest-federal-minimum wage-is-increased-in-excess of-\$4.25-per-hour,-the minimum wage must be increased-to-the-same amount,-effective-on-the-same date as the increase-in-the-federal minimum-wage, but in-no-case-may the minimum-wage-exceed-\$5.15 per-hour. Starting October 1, 2001, the minimum hourly wage is \$5.65 per hour. Starting October 1, 2002, the minimum hourly wage is \$6.25 per hour.

This bill provides for an increase in the state minimum wage to \$5.65 per hour beginning October 1, 2001 and to \$6.25 per hour beginning October 1, 2002.
