2	SUMMARY

The resolve, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," directs the Department of Transportation to work with the Federal Highway Administration, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials and the Maine Turnpike Authority to improve the system of interstate and exit numbering in the State. This amendment instead provides that the Legislature endorses the idea of those entities cooperating.
