Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

8	The board shall adopt and enforce standards that meet the
	requirements of the federal Tier 2 motor vehicle emission
10	standards and gasoline sulfur control requirements, as found in
	40 Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 80 and 86. Rules adopted
12	pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined
	<u>in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.</u>

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill amends emission standards for new motor vehicles
	to make Maine's standards consistent with the latest federal
20	standards. It requires the Board of Environmental Protection
	within the Department of Environmental Protection to adopt the
22	same standards as the United States Environmental Protection
	Agency in its most recent rulemaking, the "Tier 2" standards.
