Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA c. 229** is enacted to read:

8 **IMPORTED GOODS**

10 **§1500-G. Importation of wreaths prohibited**

12 A person may not import a wreath made in Canada into this
14 State. A person who violates this section commits a civil
16 violation for which a forfeiture of \$100 and \$10 per wreath for a
18 first offense and \$500 and \$50 per wreath for a 2nd and each
20 succeeding offense must be adjudged.

22 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill provides that a person may not import a wreath
made in Canada into this State. A person who violates this
provision commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of
\$100 and \$10 per wreath for a first offense and \$500 and \$50 per
wreath for a 2nd and each succeeding offense must be adjudged.
