Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6505-C, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 536, Pt. A, §8, is amended to read:
- 2. Exemptions. A person may fish for or take for personal use an-eel <u>eels</u> in the coastal waters of the State by speargun, harpoon, trap or hook and line and may possess or transport that eel <u>eels that person has taken</u>.
