
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 395, L.D. 1310, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Health Data Organization Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 22 by striking out all of paragraph Q and inserting in its place the following:

'Q. In order to protect the public health and welfare, to state governmental entities only insofar as necessary to enable those entities to perform their duties when reporting is required or authorized by law.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a regulated insurance entity or organization may disclose personal information about a consumer to a state governmental entity only insofar as necessary for that entity to perform its duties when reporting is required or authorized by law.
