SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 395, L.D. 1310, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Health Data Organization Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 24.


FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the allocation to the Maine Health Data Organization of \$467,109 in fiscal year 2002-03.

As amended, this bill raises the cap on the amount of funds that may be collected through assessments by the Maine Health Data Organization to \$1,346,906 in fiscal year 2002-03. In order to expend these additional funds, the Maine Health Data Organization will require an Other Special Revenue allocation or an increase in allotment via financial order.
