  - **SUMMARY**

20 This amendment removes the licensing provisions of the bill, provides that the Director of the Office of Substance Abuse 22 reports directly to the Commissioner of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services and deletes the 24 requirement that the appointment of a person to that position be reviewed by the joint standing committee of the Legislature 26 having jurisdiction over human resource matters prior to taking office.
