SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 988, L.D. 1325, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Maine Research and Development Evaluation Fund"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "S13122-L." by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

'4. Repeal; lapse of funds. This section is repealed June 30, 2006. Unexpended funds in the fund lapse to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment adds a sunset provision that would terminate the transfer of funds from certain accounts to the Maine Research and Development Evaluation Fund effective June 30, 2006. Termination of the transfers would increase the funds available in certain accounts by the amount of the former transfers from those accounts. The unappropriated surplus of the General Fund would increase by the amount of unexpended funds remaining in the fund on June 30, 2006.
