SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 991, L.D. 1328, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Registers of Deeds"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 8 paragraphs after the title and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:'

Further amend the amendment in the 9th paragraph after the title in the first line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 3." and inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment by striking all of the 2nd paragraph before the fiscal note (page 2, lines 9 to 11 in amendment)

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment strikes everything in the bill and in Committee Amendment "A" except the extension until January 1, 2005 of the sunset of the local surcharge, eliminating all costs and removing consideration of any mandate.'

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**SUMMARY**

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This amendment strikes the bill, as amended by Committee  
Amendment "A," except that it retains that provision that extends
