2 **Sec. 1. Creating health days. Resolved:** That the Department of
Human Services, Bureau of Health shall create a Health Days in
4 Maine program that promotes responsible health options, exercise,
proper eating habits and stress management for the well-being of
6 the citizens of Maine. The program must focus on each major age
group, create a health theme each month and consist of strategies
for healthy living in Maine.

 Sec. 2. Authority to use funds. Resolved: That the Department of
10 Human Services may use funds from the Fund for a Healthy Maine to
create the program.
