	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, the Crossroads Landfill in Norridgewock is a
6	contentious local issue; and
8	Whereas, the Crossroads Landfill currently may be emitting
10	methane gas into the environment; and
10	Whereas, the emission of methane gas may be a serious health
12	and safety hazard and may be aggravating the contention surrounding the site; and

16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
