COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1004, L.D. 1341, Bill, "An Act to Permit the Submission of Citizens' Initiatives and Citizens' Vetoes to School Districts"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The requirement that certain local school policies and rules could be subject to direct citizen initiative and citizen veto processes represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs are indeterminate. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, the local school administrative units and municipalities may not be required to implement these changes.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
