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20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 414, L.D. 1358, Bill, "An
Act to Require Truth in Advertising of Natural Water"

22 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the
24 following:

26 'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §562-B is enacted to read:

28 **§562-B. Identification of source of water sold in containers
and intended for human consumption**

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32 The label on water that is sold in the State in containers
and that is intended for human consumption must identify the
location of the water body, well or public water supply from
34 which the water was obtained.'

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SUMMARY

40 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires
that water sold in the State in containers and intended for human
consumption must identify the location of the water body, well or
42 public water supply from which the water was obtained.
