COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1016, L.D. 1365, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funding for Low-barrier Homeless Teen Shelters"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

Further amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before the concept draft summary the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
