This bill proposes to establish a schedule of priorities for the disbursement of funding for homeless teen shelters and homes between the 3 regions of the State. Under the proposed schedule, projects in region 2 must be given first priority.

This bill would provide an appropriation of \$500,000 for homeless teen shelters and homes at least \$300,000 of which would be appropriated for homeless teen shelters and homes in region 2.
