## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1022, L.D. 1371

This bill includes an annual Other Special Revenue allocation of \$70,000 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to establish the Dairy Industry Fund.

The establishment of a fee to be paid by milk producers will increase fee collections. The estimated annual increase of dedicated revenue to the Dairy Industry Fund administered by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources is \$70,000
beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that a dealer deducts the 1¢ per 16 hundredweight for deposit into the Dairy Industry Fund from the amount paid to a Maine milk producer.
