If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$44,097,720 with principal payments of \$35,600,000 and interest payments of approximately \$8,497,720.'

#### 10 SUMMARY

12 This amendment is the minority report. The amendment decreases the amount of the bond issue from \$65,200,000 to The funds provided by this bond issue, in the 14 \$35,600,000. amount of \$35,600,000, will be used to fund a variety of 16 improvements at the State's public universities, the Maine Maritime Academy and other public learning centers. Four million 18 dollars of the bond proceeds are allocated to the University of Maine for the construction of an addition to the library and the 20 renewal fee for the art classroom facility. Five million dollars are allocated to the University of Maine at Farmington for the 22 construction of an education classroom facility. Six million dollars are allocated to the University of Maine at Presque Isle 24 for the construction of a health and physical education complex. Nine million dollars are allocated to the University of Southern 26 Maine for the construction of a community education facility and the renewal of the combination of a classroom and library. Four 28 million dollars are allocated to the Maine Maritime Academy for the construction and renovation of dormitories, classrooms and 30 One million four hundred thousand dollars allocated to the Maine Technical College System to renovate and 32 equip classroom space at the Bath Higher Education Center. million nine hundred thousand dollars are allocated to the 34 University of Maine System to renovate and equip classroom space at the Western Maine University Center. Two hundred thousand dollars are allocated to the Maine Technical College System to 36 renovate and equip classroom space at the Katahdin Area K-Tech 38 Center. Four million dollars are allocated to the University of Maine System for capital infrastructure and equipment research and development. One hundred thousand dollars are 40 allocated to the University of Maine System to renovate and equip 42 classroom space at the Calais Center.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
