42 The reinstatement of driver's licenses for persons suspended
43 for driving an uninsured motor vehicle and for those involved in

2 an accident while driving an uninsured motor vehicle, as well as
the fines collected for these offenses, will increase Highway
4 Fund revenue collected by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the
Department of the Secretary of State by \$1,983,764 and \$2,644,970
6 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively.


8 This bill includes Highway Fund allocations of \$421,354 and
\$540,998 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for
10 the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the
Secretary of State to cover the cost of one Hearings Examiner
12 position, one Clerk Typist IV position, 4 Clerk Typist III
positions, 4 Clerk Typist II positions, 2 Data Entry Specialist
14 positions and operating costs necessary to administer a driver's
license suspension and reinstatement process.

16 This bill will increase Other Special Revenue to the
Judicial Department, Government Operations Surcharge Fund by
18 \$150,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$200,000 in fiscal year
2002-03, to the Department of Public Safety, Maine Criminal
20 Justice Academy by \$30,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$40,000 in
22 fiscal year 2002-03 and to the University of Maine, Community
Policing Institute by \$30,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$40,000
24 in fiscal year 2002-03. This bill includes Other Special Revenue
allocations for those agencies to authorize the expenditure of
26 this additional revenue.

28 The Judicial Department will incur some additional costs
associated with the increase in certain fines. These costs can
30 be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

32 **SUMMARY**

34 This amendment adds a necessary allocation section and
replaces the fiscal note from the committee amendment with an
36 updated fiscal note.
