This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment strikes and replaces the bill with an appropriation to the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program in the Department of Education so that additional funding can be allocated to the geographic isolation adjustment to the school funding formula above and beyond the funds already included in the current services budget for fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal year 2002-03. The amendment replaces the emergency preamble and the emergency clause and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
