COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1036, L.D. 1393, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Professional Skills of Maine's Educational Technicians"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "all" and inserting in its place the following: 'applicable'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that the Commissioner of Education recognize applicable work experience credits earned through work apprenticeship programs offered by the Department of Labor when certifying educational technicians.
