2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13023, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 1997, c.  
553, §4, is amended to read:

6 **2. Qualifications.** The commissioner shall adopt rules to  
7 define the function, preparation and supervision for the  
8 different levels of educational technician authorization. The  
9 rules must recognize all work experience credits earned by  
10 educational technicians through completion of work apprenticeship  
11 programs offered by the Department of Labor. Rules adopted under  
12 this subsection are routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5,  
chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill requires that the rules used in defining the  
19 qualifications of educational technicians must recognize work  
20 experience credits earned through completion of apprenticeship  
21 programs offered by the Department of Labor.
