4	§4634. Right to breast-feed
6	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a mother may
8	breast-feed her baby in any location, public or private, where the mother is otherwise authorized to be.

14	This bill amends the Maine Human Rights Act to declare that a mother has the right to breast-feed her baby in any location,
16	whether public or private, as long as she is otherwise authorized to be in that location. This bill is based on a similar New York
18	law.
